students with a secondary school diploma who are keen to pursue a career in hospitality.







Teaching Body

Our teachers are highly respected professionals in the London hospitality industry, most of whom have international work experience.

The internships will take place exclusively in 4*-5* star hotels.






































Fees






Scholarship

Our sponsors provide 15 scholarships worth £600 (VAT incl) for the first 3 students who send the application, £480 for the next 4. And 8 additional scholarship given out on a first-come-first served basis worth £400.









fill in the English CV and submit the online application form Candidates who are admitted onto the Master should pay a of £500 (VAT incl) within 48 hours of being accepted (this is non-refundable if you no longer wish to participate in the Master).

Due to the limited number of participants, the earliest applications are more likely to be successful.

Admission

To apply candidates should:

fill in the English CV and send it to master@italchamind.org.uk; submit the online application form;

Once the application has been received, the Chamber will contact the candidate via email to arrrange a telephone interview with one of our English native speakers in order to assess the candidate's command of the language. After that the candidate will be informed about success of their application and the possible grant of one of the scholarships. The deadline for submitting applications is when the maximum number of participants has been reached. Considering that there are a limited number of places, the Italian Chamber of Commerce for the UK reserves the right to accept or reject applications.









Students must attend at least 75% of lectures

Certificate

To be granted the Master certificate, students must attend at least 75% of lectures.

The final written test ends the first theoritical part of the Master. It is made up of openended questions and its aim i to test how much the student have understood during the lectures. The students will not receive a mark.
