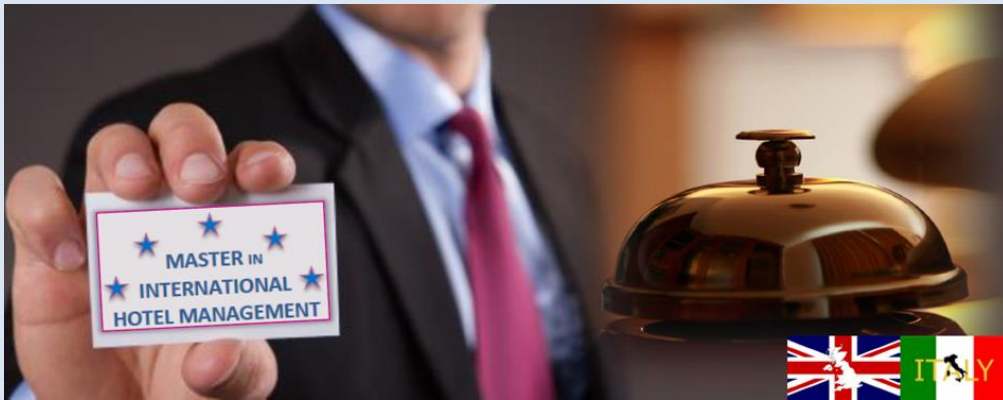


STUDENTS' TESTIMONIES

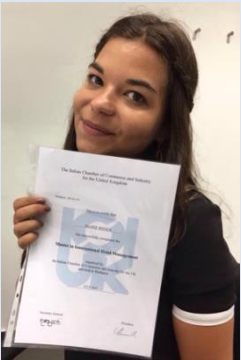

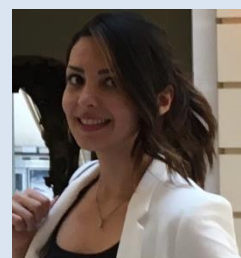
Moreover, the advantage of this Master is the opportunity of connection with 4/5 stars hotel and have internships of 3/6 months period.

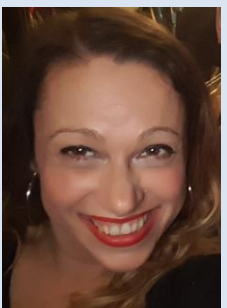

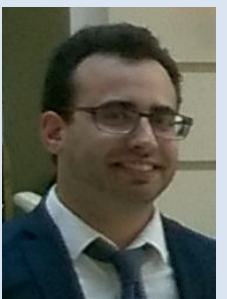
